He served as the Minister of Post and Telecommunications in the Palestinian unity Government in 1996-2002. In 2009, President Abbas appointed Sheikh Imad al-Falouji as a member of the Islamic-Christian commission for patronizing Jerusalem and the holy sites
- Sheikh Raed Badir, leading Islamic law (Shari'a) arbitrator and member of the southern branch of the Palestinian Ulama Council, Israel
- Dr. Ali M. Musleh Sartawi, former Minister of Justice and Dean of the Faculty of Law of An-Najah University, Member of the Palestinian National Security Council and Member of the Legal Advisory Board of the President, Nablus, West Bank

**Jewish:**

- Rabbi Michael Melchior, former Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs (1999 - 2002), Minister for Social Affairs and Deputy Minister of Education, Culture and Sports (2005), community Rabbi in Jerusalem, President of the Mosaica Religious Peace Initiative
- Rabbi Avraham Giesser, Rabbi of Ofra and Council Head for the state religious educational system of Israel
- Dr. Adina Bar Shalom, Head of an academic institution for ultra-orthodox women in Israel, an activist for coexistence and peace, and a public figure of public debate, awarded the Israel Prize in 2014 (daughter of the former Sephardic Chief Rabbi of Israel – Obadia Youssef - and the oldest sister of the present Sephardic Chief Rabbi of Israel), Tel Aviv
