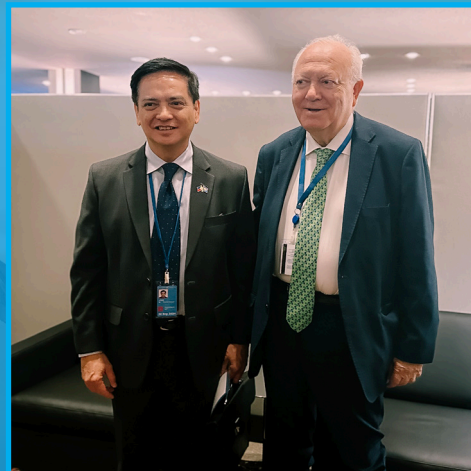

Preparations are Underway for the 10th UNAOC Global Forum (Cascais, Portugal, 25–27 November 2024)



UNAOC and the Permanent Mission of Portugal to the United Nations hosted a joint briefing for the UNAOC Group of Friends on the upcoming **10th UNAOC Global Forum**, which is scheduled to take place in Cascais, Portugal from 25–27 November.

The informal briefing, co-chaired by **USG Miguel Moratinos** and **H.E. Rui Vinhas**, the Permanent Representative of Portugal to the United Nations, focused on the latest programme of the event, the registration procedure, protocol arrangements as well as the expected outcomes of the Global Forum. **Ms. Nihal Saad**, UNAOC Director, moderated the discussion and led the presentation. **Ms. Julie Ladan**, UNAOC Public Information Officer, and **Mr. Stefano Guerra** of the Mission of Portugal, also shared additional information about online registration and other logistical details. A UNAOC delegation visited Cascais, Portugal as part of the preparations for the **10th UNAOC Global Forum**. The team met with officials and members of the national organizing committee to finalize the content and logistical aspects of the upcoming landmark event. The Forum, which will be convened under the overarching theme, “**United in Peace: Restoring Trust, Reshaping the Future – Reflecting on Two Decades of Dialogue for Humanity**”, will take place on 25–27 November.

On the margins of the Yerevan Dialogue, Mr. Moratinos met with the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Armenia, **H.E. Mr. Ararat Mirzoyan**. The High Representative reaffirmed his readiness to provide support to efforts aimed at achieving sustainable peace in the region. (11 September)

The High Representative addressed the high-level **Yerevan Dialogue** in Armenia, which was co-organized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Armenia and the Observer Research Foundation (ORF).

Speaking in a panel entitled “**Strengthening Multiculturalism in a Divided World**”, the High Representative emphasized the importance of intercultural dialogue in rebuilding trust and realizing a shared future. “It is the first step in a long process towards confidence-building measures,” he said.

Also in the panel were **H.E. Mr. Mehdi Jomaa**, Former Prime Minister of Tunisia, **H.E. Nikola Stojanovic**, the State Secretary of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Serbia, and other distinguished speakers. (9-11 September)



USG Moratinos and his delegation were received by **His Holiness Karekin II**, Supreme Patriarch and Catholicos of All Armenians at the Mother See of Holy Etchmiadzin in Armenia. They discussed the importance of safeguarding Armenian religious sites as an essential element for sustainable peace in the region. (10 September)

USG Moratinos participated in the **Ohrid Cultural Diplomacy Forum 2024** in Ohrid, Macedonia, which was organized under the theme, “**Young Leaders for International Cooperation, Cultural Understanding and Peace**”.

The High Representative was a keynote guest in a special discussion entitled, “**Bridging Cultures: The UN Alliance of Civilizations’ Impact on Global Peace**”, moderated by **Dr. Ivan Ivanov**, ICAC Executive Chairman. 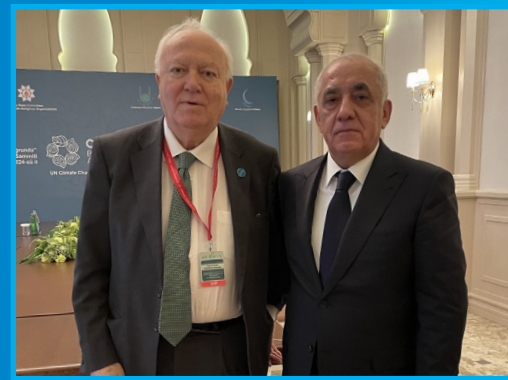

They discussed the importance of promoting intercultural and interreligious dialogue as a tool for conflict prevention and for fostering social cohesion. (12 October)

On the sidelines of the Global Summit of Religious Leaders in Baku, the High Representative was received by **H.E. Mr. Ali Asadov**, the Prime Minister of Azerbaijan. They discussed a wide range of issues of mutual interest.

The High Representative participated in the **Global Summit of Religious Leaders** in Baku, Azerbaijan, organized by the Caucasus Muslims' Board, the Muslim Council of Elders, the COP29 Presidency, the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), and the Azerbaijan State Committee on Work with Religious Institutions.

A precursor to the 29th session of the **Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP29)**, the event focused on the theme **"World Religions for a Green Planet"** under the patronage of **Mr. Ilham Aliyev**, President of the Republic of Azerbaijan, and in the presence of **Mr. Ali Asadov**, Prime Minister of the State of Azerbaijan. Prominent figures including global religious leaders, representatives of faith-based organizations, political leaders, senior officials, academics and experts in the field of environment and climate, were in attendance.

Speaking at the high-level opening ceremony, **USG Moratinos** emphasized the important role of faith leaders "to bring a unique perspective to climate change issues". He further stated, "As in all other global issues, religious leaders bring to the table an aspect that is often overlooked, willingly or unwillingly, and that is the human aspect. They raise their moral voice to remind politicians of universal values such as compassion, justice and human dignity."

They discussed ongoing partnerships and NGIC's participation in the upcoming 10th UNAOC Global Forum in Cascais, Portugal.

HIGHLIGHTS: GLOBAL EVENTS AND HIGH-LEVEL MEETINGS



In the presence of **His Majesty, King Felipe VI of Spain**, the High Representative for UNAOC addressed the **United Nations International Conference on Victims of Terrorism**, which was organized by the United Nations Office of Counter-Terrorism (UNOCT) and the Kingdom of Spain, from 8 - 9 October 2024 at the Palacio de Congresos Europa in Vitoria-Gasteiz, Spain.

The International Conference aimed to express solidarity with all victims of terrorism around the world and review progress on the international victims of terrorism agenda, as a direct outcome of the UN Global Congress of Victims of Terrorism held in New York in 2022. **USG Moratinos** addressed the high-level segment, which featured Ministerial statements, interventions from Heads of Organizations, and remarks from eminent speakers. His Majesty, King Felipe VI of Spain, delivered the keynote address. (8 October)



USG Moratinos participated in the **Euro-Mediterranean Civil Society Conference** entitled “**Reclaiming our Shared Humanity. Countering Polarisation, Dehumanisation, and Radicalisation driven by the Middle East Conflict**”, organized by the European Institute of the Mediterranean (IEMED) in Barcelona, Spain. The event gathered more than 200 civil society representatives from across the Euro-Mediterranean space, who are committed to the universality of human rights and the promotion of intercultural dialogue, mutual understanding, and peace. Speaking in a panel on “**How the Conflict Drives Polarization and Hate; Advancing Peaceful and Inclusive Societies in the Context of the Middle East Conflict**”, the High Representative highlighted the ongoing efforts of UNAOC in conflict prevention, combating hatred, and fostering cohesion. The High Representative for UNAOC participated in a workshop on **“Working Together to Counter Antisemitism: A Global Human Rights Challenge,”** held in Palais des Nations, UN Geneva. The workshop, organized by the Office of the U.S. Permanent Representative to the U.N. Human Rights Council, aimed to provide a comprehensive platform for discussing the critical issue of antisemitism, fostering greater understanding and collaboration among international stakeholders.

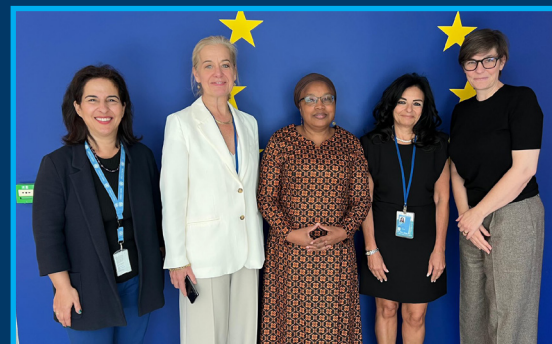
Addressing the session, USG Moratinos emphasized the need to condemn antisemitic incidents and promote educational and awareness-raising efforts to counter antisemitism and address other forms of identity-based hatred and religious intolerance. “We should intensify our prevention efforts, to denounce discrimination and to resolve conflicts before they engulf everything and everyone,” he said.

Other distinguished speakers were **Ambassador Deborah Lipstadt**, U.S. Special Envoy to Monitor and Combat Antisemitism; **Ambassador Michèle Taylor**, U.S. Permanent Representative to the U.N. Human Rights Council; **Dr. Felix Klein**, Federal Government Commissioner for Jewish Life in Germany and the Fight Against Antisemitism; and **Dr. h.c. Katharina von Schnurbein**, EJ Coordinator on Combating Antisemitism and Fostering Jewish Life. (4 September)



UNAOC Director, **Ms. Nihal Saad**, participated in the **Eighth Meeting of the Secretary-General’s High-Level Action Group on Preventing Violent Extremism** organized by the United Nations Office of Counter-Terrorism (UNOCT) at the United Nations Headquarters in New York.

The strategic discussion aimed to identify ways to strengthen efforts in preventing and countering violent extremism (PCVE) in support of the Pact for the Future implementation. UNAOC is a co-chair of the PCVE Working Group of the Counter-Terrorism Compact Coordination Committee. (29 October)

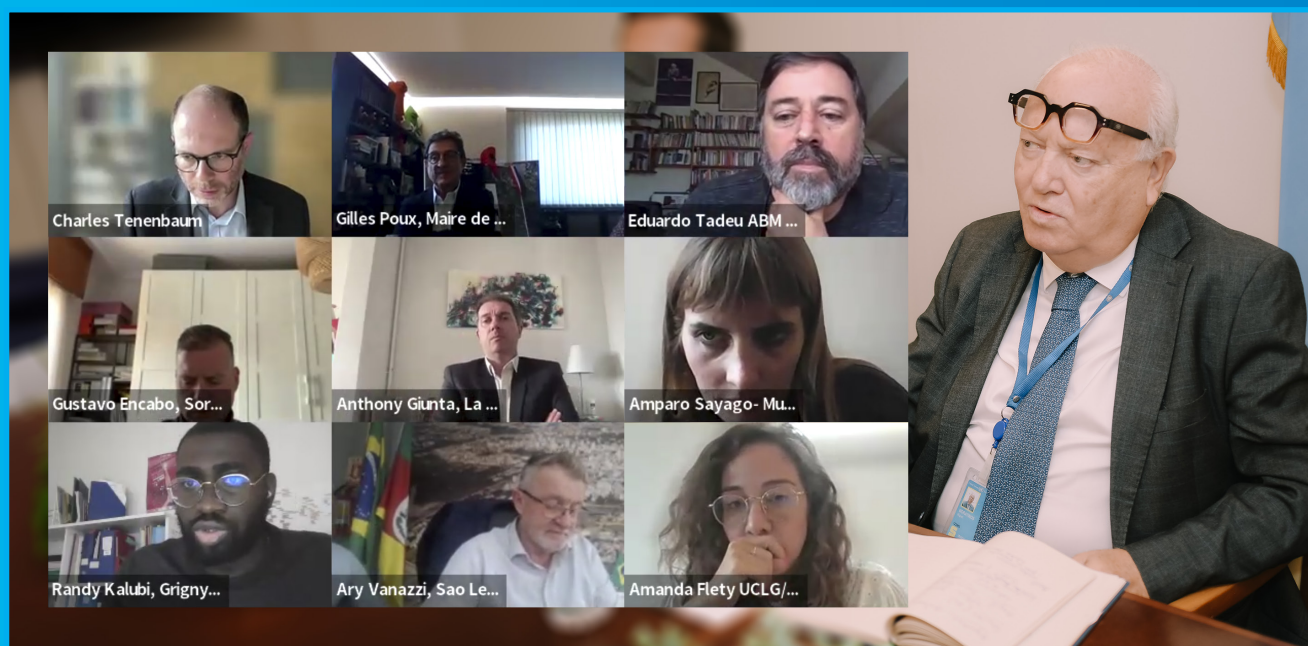


Ms. Nihal Saad, UNAOC Director, participated in a side event on **“Freedom of religion or belief as a tool for the promotion of peace”** organized by the Delegation of the European Union to the United Nations in New York. The side event aimed to offer a space to further explore

the centrality to peace of freedom of thought, conscience, religion, or belief drawing on global insights. During the session, Ms. Saad highlighted the work of UNAOC in fostering dialogue among different cultures and religions to create empathy and understanding. “Promoting the right to freedom of religion is a necessary tool for sustainable peace. People need to feel safe in expressing their beliefs,” she said. (25 October)

The High Representative spoke with members of the Spanish press during an informal breakfast session organized by the **Barcelona Centre for International Affairs (CIDOB)**, a research institute for international relations based in Barcelona, Spain.

Mr. Moratinos addressed the volatile geo-political climate and emphasized the important role of UNAOC in fostering dialogue and creating a sustainable pathway to peace. (10 October)



UNAOC hosted a virtual meeting as a follow-up to its **"City Dialogue"** series, which aims to strengthen interculturalism in urban spaces and foster cooperation among municipalities and cities worldwide. Its last iteration, entitled **"Building Intercultural Cities"**, was hosted in La Courneuve, France in November last year. During the online meeting – which was attended by representatives from Africa, Europe, and the Americas, as well as the United Cities and Local Government (UCLG) – **USG Moratinos** highlighted action points and next steps for the series. He also encouraged annual engagement among cities, the implementation of shared projects, and showcasing this cooperation at the upcoming 10th UNAOC Global Forum in Cascais, Portugal. The High Representative met with **H.E. Mr. Philemon Yang**, President of the 79th Session of the General Assembly, at the United Nations Headquarters in New York. They discussed areas of mutual interest and explored opportunities for deeper collaboration on shared goals. (8 November)



The High Representative met with **H.E. Mr. Marcelo Eliseo Scappini Ricciardi**, Permanent Representative of Paraguay to the United Nations. They discussed strengthening their collaboration, particularly in the area of promoting a culture of peace through sports. (8 November)



The High Representative received the Permanent Representative of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia to the United Nations, **H.E. Mr. Abdulaziz Alwasil**, at the UNAOC office in New York. On the sidelines of the 79th session of the UN General Assembly, the High Representative addressed the Opening Ceremony of the **Nizami Ganjavi International Center (NGIC) #XXXHLM** Meeting in New York. Focusing on the theme, “Trust and Global Governance, Climate Action: Linking the UN Summit of the Future with COP29”, the event brought together global leaders to address critical issues concerning climate action and governance.

In his remarks, the High Representative commended the adoption of the Pact of the Future and the opportunity it provides for the international community “to recommit to global solidarity and the promise of advancing shared security and prosperity.”

The high-level opening featured the participation of high-level dignitaries, including government officials, policymakers, and leaders from various sectors. These included **H.E. Ms. Vaira Vīķe-Freiberga, Former President of Latvia**; H.E. Theresa May, former Prime Minister of the United Kingdom; **H.E. Mr. Csaba Kórosi**, President of the 77th session of the UN General Assembly; **H.E. Mr. Mukhtar Babayev**, Minister of Ecology and Natural Resources of the Republic of Azerbaijan; **H.E. Mr. Ismail Serageldin**, Co-Chair of NGIC and former Vice President of the World Bank; **Ms. Kerry Kennedy**, President of the Robert F. Kennedy Human Rights; **Mr. Achim Steiner**, Administrator of UNDP; as well as **Mr. Tedros Ghebreyesus**, Director General of WHO. **H.E. Ms. María Fernanda Espinosa**, President of the 73rd session of the UN General Assembly, moderated the session. (25 September)

In the framework of #UNGA79, UNAOC and the Permanent Mission of the Republic of Uzbekistan to the United Nations organized a high-level panel discussion on “**Promoting Peaceful and Inclusive Societies for Sustainable Development through Intercultural and Interreligious Dialogue**”.

USG Moratinos addressed the high-level opening segment and underscored that “intercultural dialogue and interreligious dialogue are essential tools [...] to build bridges of understanding, challenge stereotypes, and foster mutual respect.”

Moderated by UNAOC Director **Ms. Nihal Saad**, the event also featured remarks from **H.E. Mr. Bakhtiyor Saidov**, Minister of Foreign Affairs of Uzbekistan; **H.E. Mr. Péter Szijjártó**, Minister of Foreign Affairs and Trade of Hungary; **H.E. Mr. Martin Chungong**, Secretary-General of the Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU); **H.E. Sheikh Salem Al Qassimi**, Minister of Culture of UAE; **H.E. Mr. Akan Rakhmetullin**, First Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs of Kazakhstan; **H.E. Mr. Vladimir Voronkov**, Under Secretary General for Counter-Terrorism; and other distinguished speakers. (26 September)



In the lead-up to the UN Summit of the Future (SotF), USG Moratinos addressed a high-level Pre-Summit event organized by the Sustainable Development Solutions Network (SDSN) at Columbia University in New York. Speaking at the panel session entitled, **“Turning the Tide: Exploring the Ethical, Political, and Practical Dimensions of Global Peace and Security,”** he emphasized the need to “put peace at the center” of the UN’s work. “Without peace, there will be no security,” he said.

The discussion focused on the outcomes of the SotF as part of its annual International Conference on Sustainable Development (ICSD). The panel also featured **H.E. Judge Mohamed Abdelsalam**, Secretary-General of the Muslim Council of Elders and Co-President of Religions for Peace, and **H.E. Mr. Vuk Jeremić**, former President of the General Assembly, among others. (20 September)

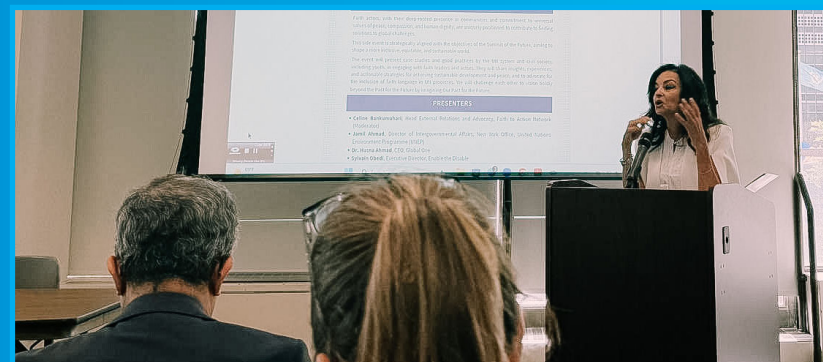

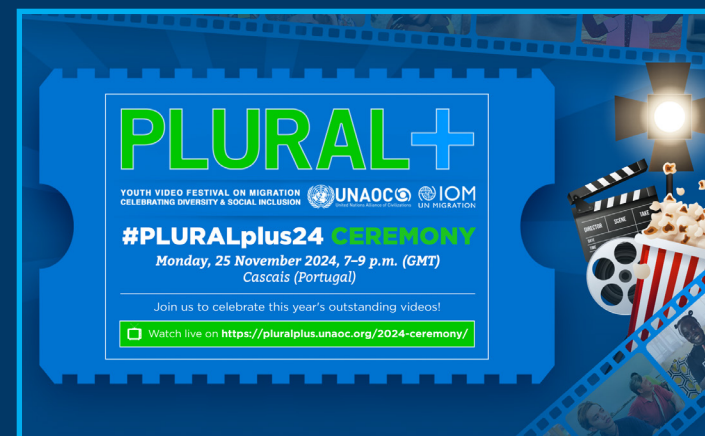

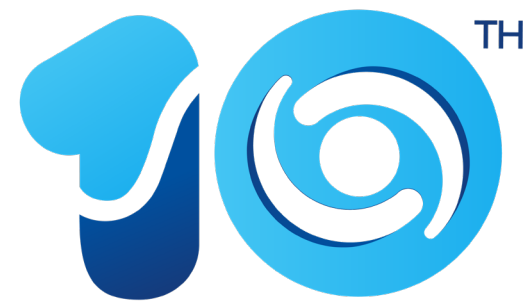
